Notes

- 1 The Office - Tenant Light and Power is an estimate based upon whole building metering and office areas.
- 2 A more accurate measurement of office space and an increase in office staff, has resulted in a higher consumption value
- 3 There was a one-off project requiring ~14000l of oil to run a boiler
- 4 There was a drop in kilometres travelled by passenger vehicles in FY15, in addition 5 vehicles were retired from the pool fleet
- 5 More accurate measurement of office area, including corridors & toilets
- 6 There was an increase in tenant office staff of 10
- 7 The reduction does not reflect an actual reduction in floor space, but a more accurate measurement of building area in FY15
