POSITION PURPOSE

The primary objective of the General Manager Major Capital Programs is to strategically lead Major Capital program directors, program managers and project managers to successfully deliver major, complex, multi-disciplinary ANSTO projects from initiation to handover across all campuses. The General Manager Major Capital Programs develops and oversees diverse Project through the appropriate governance and program/project lifecycle. Ensures capital expenditure is prioritised, allocated and monitored in line with the organisation's financial and strategic directions, and that projects are delivered in line with approved business cases.

The General Manager Major Capital Programs oversees strategic planning and prioritisation, providing expert and strategic advice aligned to ANSTO strategic objectives. This includes the governance, delivery, quality, risk and, in conjunction with the project managers, budget management of all Major Capital and Decommissioning projects.

The General Manager Major Capital Programs reports to the Group Executive Major Capital Programs & Chief Engineer. The position has several direct and indirect reports and provides leadership, management, and guidance across ANSTO Capital and Decommissioning portfolio, programs, project managers and project teams, which include engineers, technical staff, site supervisors, consultants, and contractors.

The role also provides ANSTO executive and Capital Committee with expert, independent and evidence-based advice, and recommendations.

ORGANISATIONAL ENVIRONMENT

ANSTO leverages great science to deliver big outcomes. We partner with scientists and engineers and apply new technologies to provide real-world benefits. Our work improves human health, saves lives, builds our industries and protects the environment. ANSTO is the home of Australia's most significant landmark and national infrastructure for research. Thousands of scientists from industry and academia benefit from gaining access to state-of-the-art instruments every year.

ACCOUNTABILITIES & RESPONSIBILITIES

Key Accountabilities

ANSTO Major Capital Programs has a direct capital budget of \$83M p. a. and an indirect budget of \$3M where staff form a critical part of delivery of project.

- Lead and direct the functions of the ANSTO Major capital program, including effective management of staff, budget, and resources; and the development and implementation of strategies to improve work practices, systems, and processes to ensure the delivery of high-quality outcomes.
- Provide expert leadership to develop, continually review and maintain a holistic and effective strategy for the execution of Major Capital programs across ANSTO, aligned with ANSTO 5-year capital and decommissioning plan.
- Prioritise and allocate capital and decommissioning expenditure of the Portfolio in accordance with financial delegation.
- Oversee the governance and execution of programs and are on-time, within approved budget, and appropriately implemented in accordance with ANSTO's quality, safety, environmental and regulatory requirements.
- Manage and develop a team of Project and Program Managers to deliver a variety of high-profile, complex projects and programs.
- Lead and manage the Major Capital (\$640M) Program.
- Provide expert, independent and evidence-based advice, and recommendations to the ANSTO
 executive, Board and Government on the management and strategic prioritisation of Major Capital
 programs and projects.
- Monitor, analyse and report on the execution of Major Capital projects.
- Ensure the Major Capital portfolio projects are communicated, understood, and aligned to priorities throughout the organisation
- Support clients in the development, execution, and resolution of complex sustainability, legal, procurement, financial and contracting activities.
- Provide assurance to the Executive, Board and Government that projects are executed in accordance with the organisation's project management methodology.
- Lead and develop the implementation of governance procedures and processes from the Capital Program Management Office into the strategic planning and operations.
- Provide technically sound program / project management advice and support with the aims of satisfying the stakeholder requirements and all associated safety, quality assurance, commercial, technical, and regulatory requirements.
- Build and improve the capability of ANSTO Major Capital project managers.
- Provide timely and accurate portfolio reporting and strategic portfolio advice to internal and external stakeholders.
- Deliver stakeholder focused solutions with the ability to influence, negotiate and liaise with senior staff including developing quality verbal and written reports and presenting to the Chief Engineer, COO, CFO and CEO.
- Act as liaison between the divisions to ensure that where Major Capital Programs staff are required/used the delivery of the project.
- Deliver to the IBP Demand and Supply meetings the relevant information to inform decisions about the needs for, and supply of, resources to allow for the completion of Major Capital Programs scope, time, and budget.
- Undertake additional duties as required and during periods of leave of other staff.

Decision Making

- The position works within a framework of legislation, policies, professional standards, and resource
 parameters with considerable independence in determining how to achieve objectives, including
 deciding on methods and approaches, business and project planning, and allocation of resources.
- The ANSTO values and organisation Corporate Plan, Business Plan, Excellence programs, Capital Committee Charter provide the context for the position.
- The position is fully accountable for the accuracy, integrity, and quality of the content of advice
 provided to the Group Executive ANSTO Maintenance and Engineering and is required to ensure
 that decisions are based on sound evidence, but at times may be required to make effective
 judgements under pressure or in the absence of complete information or expert advice.
- Key work priorities within the context of agreed work plans and will consult with the Chief Executive Officer, Chief Operating Officer and Chief Financial Officer on the more complex, sensitive, and political issues that have a significant impact on the organisation's program/project management methodology, delivery and funding.
- The levels of authority delegated to this position are those approved and issued by the Chief Executive Officer. All delegations will be in line with the ANSTO Delegation Manual AS-1682 (as amended or replaced).

Key Challenges

- Develop and implement a holistic strategic plan for Major Capital Programs that aligns with ANSTO's 5yr capital and decommissioning plans and supports the successful delivery of major, complex, multi-disciplinary ANSTO projects in full compliance with evolving customer, stakeholder, and regulatory requirements.
- Oversee the execution of high-profile programs and projects meeting challenging timeframes, budgets, and requirements with constrained resources.
- Improve the performance and efficiency of the overall Major Capital Program.
- Resource demand and planning across multiple programs drawing from a limited resources pool for skills set that is in high demand.
- Prioritisation and delivery of Major Capital and decommission programs of that have dependency on shutdowns or other projects/programs.
