

ANSTO Personal Information Collection Notice

In this privacy collection notice 'we', 'us', 'our' and 'ANSTO' means the Australian Nuclear Science and Technology Organisation ABN 47 956 969 590. We will collect, use, and disclose your details in accordance with this collection notice, ANSTO's Privacy Policy, the Privacy Act 1988 and the National Archives Act 1983.

Why is ANSTO collecting this information

We collect individuals' information for the purpose of visitation assessment and/or relevant supporting activities, ie Visa support letters, agreements. This information includes the attendees: first and last name, nationality, employment contact details ie email address, contact number, employee/position title and employer/organisation name. We collect this information to enable individuals to engage with ANSTO for a specific purpose (**Primary Purpose**). We may also use this information for certain authorised secondary purposes.

What are the consequences of not providing this information?

If an individual does not wish for information to be collected they can decline to disclose it. However, in those circumstances, ANSTO may be unable to facilitate the relevant engagement. Any questions about ANSTO's privacy practices can be forwarded to privacy@ansto.gov.au

Who will my information be disclosed to?

Personal information may be provided to third parties as required in support of the assessment process, and as authorised or required by law.

Disclosure overseas

Personal information will not be disclosed overseas unless authorised or required by law.
