



VISITING ANSTO - BUS INFORMATION FACT SHEET

It is important to all Australians that our national assets are kept secure. For this reason, ANSTO has implemented a range of safety and security measures that visitors need to observe.

Bus drivers need to familiarise themselves with the information in this fact sheet prior to visiting ANSTO.

With respect to buses transporting groups to ANSTO for tours, the following applies:

- As ANSTO is a large site, buses must remain with tour groups for the duration of the tour, to shuttle groups from venue to venue onsite.
- Buses must be emptied of all bags, cases, boxes, fuel/oil containers and any other personal belongings before going onsite:
 - When tour participants arrive at the ANSTO Discovery Centre, they must take their belongings off the bus and store them in the Discovery Centre and may use the free lockers provided in the ANSTO Discovery Centre to secure their valuables.
 - Luggage trailers must be taken off buses before buses can go onsite.
 - If tour participants need to take snacks, drinks, medical or baby supplies with them onsite, they need to be carried in a clear plastic bag.
- Bus drivers must bring their Drivers Licence with them for identification verification by ANSTO representatives on arrival at site. Adults who do not bring their identification with them on the day of the tour will not be permitted to proceed on the tour.
- All forms of photography for filming onsite are prohibited without written permission from ANSTO. Unauthorised photography may constitute an offence under the Nuclear NonProliferation (Safeguards) Act 1987.
 - Bus drivers must ensure that all camera systems aboard the bus are switched off prior to entering site. Fixed reversing cameras used for parking that do not have a recording function are permitted to remain on to assist with the safe operation of the bus.
 - Visitors, including bus drivers, are not permitted to take mobile phones or any other electronic or recording device onsite. The ANSTO Educational Officers who accompany the tour carry mobile phones and bus drivers may use these in the case of emergency. Bus companies who need to contact their driver during a tour should contact the ANSTO Discovery Centre on (02) 9717 3090.
- It is a safety and security requirement that an ANSTO Education Officer travels on board each bus participating in a tour of ANSTO. When considering bus capacity, drivers must allow for one Education Officer for every 20 tour participants to travel legally on board the bus during the tour.
- When passengers alight from the bus onsite during the tour, the driver must lock the bus and join the tour. This is a security requirement when visiting ANSTO.
- Due to road restrictions within the ANSTO site:
 - Buses should be a **maximum of 13.7 metres in length**, and preferably have both front and back steering.
 - Articulated buses cannot be used for tours of ANSTO.
- NSW road rules apply onsite at ANSTO:
 - All site traffic and parking signage needs to be observed.
 - The site speed limit is 40km/h.



Bus parking at ANSTO:

There is a designated bus parking area in the Warden Drive car park. When arriving at ANSTO:

- Turn off New Illawarra Rd onto Rutherford Ave and proceed approximately 250 metres to a roundabout at the top of the small hill.
- Turn left at the roundabout (i.e. take the first roundabout exit Warden Drive) and park in the last bay of the car park on your left.
- Passengers can then alight from the bus and walk to the ANSTO Discovery Centre, which is directly opposite the ANSTO Café next to Gate 19, using the footpaths and pedestrian crossings provided.

NOTE: In wet weather or if there are persons on your bus with mobility issues, please arrange for the tour organiser to call (02) 9717 3090 for permission to park in the Discover Centre Forecourt.
