ANSTO, through its core values, is committed to delivering excellence in our Work Health & Safety (WHS) performance. Work Health and Safety

ANSTO Objectives

ANSTO Actions

To meet our WHS commitments wherever we undertake our activities we will maintain standards and systems and set measurable objectives and targets. These will be based on a published strategy and annual plans that are supported by good industry practices that meet and exceed relevant legislated requirements. This policy and the associated systems, processes, procedures, standards and targets will continually be improved. To ensure openness and transparency, fair and just learning will underpin our approach to meet our commitments and improve our Work Health & Safety Performance.

We will maintain a program of knowledge development and transfer, leadership, improvement, monitoring and auditing of our performance. We will report publicly on our progress.
