

UPDATE Tc-99m Generator Supply – 11 October 2019

- Bulk Mo-99 shipments are scheduled to arrive at ANSTO over the weekend and next week.
- Generators will be dispatched on Sunday 13th for delivery Monday 14th predominantly for GMS, LMI and regional areas.
- Other locations will receive a generator delivery on Wednesday 16th and Friday 18th

Due to scheduled maintenance on the Safari reactor in South Africa (NTP) ANSTO will be importing bulk Mo-99 from Curium and IRE for generator supply over the coming weeks. We anticipate that all sites will receive a generator for weeks commencing 14^{th} and 21^{st} October. ANSTO customer service will contact sites directly with details when known.
